### Tell the respondent:

*Some of these questions may be sensitive, and ask about your personal experiences. We are not going to write down your name, and everything you say will be secret. Nothing that you say will be linked to you. We are looking at all the women we talk to as a group, not at individual responses.*

*Are you able to talk to me right now?*

*(If Yes, begin the survey. If No, thank the woman for her time and move on to the next person)*

### *(Doer/Non-Doer Screening Questions)*

1. How old are you?

- 1. 15-19 → Write age in "Age of Interviewee above" and Continue to question #2
- 2. Any other age → End interview and look for another participant
- 3. Won't say → End interview and look for another participant

2. Are you married?

- 1. No → Continue to question #3
- 2. Yes → End interview and look for another participant
- 3. Won't say → End interview and look for another participant

3. When was the last time you have had sex?
  - 1. A date within the last six months → Continue to question #4
  - 2. Any other response → End interview and look for another participant
  - 3. Won't say → End interview and look for another participant
4. Are you currently pregnant, or have you given birth in the last 6 months?
  - 1. No → Continue to question 5.
  - 2. Yes → End interview and look for another participant
  - 3. Won't say → End interview and look for another participant
5. Are you currently using a family planning method? (Explain to the respondent, "This means that you personally are using a method, OR that you and your partner use a condom EVERY time you have sex.)
  - 1. Yes → DOER
  - 2. No → NON-DOER
  - 3. Won't say → End interview and look for another participant

- A. To be a Doer, the young woman must say that they are between ages 15-19 in question #1, answer NO to question #2, answer response 1 to question #3, answer NO to question #4, AND answer YES to question #5. Please interview young women who meet these conditions, but do not tell them that they are a Doer.
- B. To be a Non-Doer, the young woman must say that they are between ages 15-19 in question #1, answer NO to question #2, answer response 1 to question #3, answer NO to question #4, AND answer NO to question #5. Please interview young women who meet these conditions, but do not tell them that they are a Non-Doer.
- C. If the young woman answers anything else to #1-4, and won't answer question #5, she is neither a Doer or Non-Doer ☒ Do not interview her.
